How we got input

The purpose of the Whistler Library Vision Survey is to help the Whistler Public Library plan and evaluate library users' space and technology needs.

The attached questionnaire (Appendix A) was made available from June 21st to July 24th online on Survey Monkey and in a paper format at the Whistler Public Library.


The survey opportunity was promoted through Whistler Public Library and RMOW social media posts, newsletters and notifications on their respective websites. Signs and posters spread around the library also promoted the opportunity to library users.

What we heard

Overall

The Whistler Public Library Survey engaged 485 people over the course of a few weeks in July 2017. Most of the participants were full-time Whistler residents, but visitors and people living up and down the Sea to Sky corridor participated as well. Most of the survey participants use the library every month or less, with just over a third visiting every week.

As expected, the most common use of the library is browsing, borrowing and returning books. Other activities sharing amongst them the same levels of popularity include renting DVDs/CDs, working/meetings, using computers, and attending events/classes. Most survey participants describe their experience at the library in a positive light, singling out staff as being welcoming, friendly



and helpful. This positive observation was a strong theme throughout the survey responses and was repeated again with virtually all participants noting that they feel 'safe' and 'welcome' at the library. Questions about service levels mirrored these initial feelings about the library, with 91% of participants indicating 'excellent' service quality. These strong feelings for the library resulted in a very high 'net promoter¹ score' of 79%.

Those who didn't feel they visited the library regularly suggested a broad array of reasons, though other sources for books and inconvenient hours were indicated most frequently. Busyness and other sources for books were also cited most frequently in the 'other' comments along with access to the Library.

While a few participants comments noted that 'noise' is an issue at the library, many (45%) are indifferent toward more quiet areas, with 22% indicating no need for more and 32% suggesting a need for additional areas. Comments reflected these trends, though there were also some suggestions on what could be done to manage noise in the library, such as moving collections around and enforcing phone etiquette.

The theme of 'noise' continued for a cohort of survey participants who helped push 'quiet study space' to the top of the first priority rankings for new spaces. Casting a larger net, 'more lounge space' made the top three priority positions, but was followed closely by 'quiet study space'. Quiet space comments were also popular in the general comments on design changes.

Moving from design to technology, many survey participants indicated not using the computer lab/or wifi (45%) and those that did use it on a frequent basis (every week) represented a small group (15%). The remaining 40% or so used the lab/wifi infrequently. That said, those using computers or wifi say it has helped them with important life events such as job searches, home searches, taxes and figuring our residency. Those indicating a need for additional technology most frequently suggested a desire for wireless printing capabilities.

In closing, it is clear that the Whistler Library has a large amount of 'Raving Fans' who use the facility for a variety of reasons but most prominently books. Looking forward, the organization may need to consider the desires of a specific but a sizable group of users looking for a quiet environment and additional technology access. Upcoming focus group sessions could explore this further. Future surveying might include more frequent net promoter questions sent out to users immediately after receiving services.




¹ Net Promoter Score is an index ranging from -100 to 100 that measures the willingness of customers to recommend an organization's products or services to others. Scored on a scale of 1 to 10, Customers that give you a 6 or below are Detractors, a score of 7 or 8 are called Passives, and a 9 or 10 are Promoters. To calculate your Net Promoter Score, detract the percentage of Detractors from the percentage of Promoters.

WHO PARTICIPATED?

A total of 485 people participated in the Whistler Public Library Vision Survey either online or through paper surveys. Of the participants, 74% (or 357) identified with living in Whistler full-

time. A total of 8% stated living in Squamish or Pemberton and 8% also indicated living in Whistler part-time. Of the participants, 65% identified with working full or part-time, with 14% indicating they were retired and 11% indicated they were self-employed.





MOST RECENT VISIT MOTIVATION AND EXPERIENCE

The majority of survey participants indicated that their most recent visit had to do with browsing, borrowing, reading or returning books. The responses are summarized below.

- Books browse, borrow, return, read x 227
- Kids books, programs and toys x 68
- DVDs & CDs x 39
- Work + meetings x 37
- Wifi / computer room x 25
- Events (art exhibit, movie nights, programming, etc.) x 24
- Study, classes etc. x 22
- Magazines and newspapers x 18
- Printer x 12

Other: community group, bathroom, socialize, warm-up in winter, teen lounge, volunteer, selfcheck-out, to get suggestions, sit outside, hang-out, get library card, get assistance, and to see the building.

In general, most survey participants described a positive experience. Suggestions were also provided by those feeling some improvements could be made. Responses are summarized below:

- Staff comments good, welcoming, friendly, helpful x 100
- Great, good general x 77
- Not good listed various reasons (too loud, too crowded, uncomfortable) x 52
- Loved it x 28
- Comfortable, clean, content, enjoyed, pleasant, organized, etc. x 20
- Relaxed x 18
- Happy x 18
- Easy, quick process x 15
- Used from home x 7
- Need: more desk space, more signage, and quiet zones

"I was on my laptop in the fire lounge at the back of the library doing some work. Whilst a little noisier than I would like, I always love the atmosphere in the library, and it's a great place for me to zone out and knuckle down." Survey Participant

"I will use a real example of a friend that went out of her way to say how uber friendly and helpful the staff was and how much she enjoyed the reading recommendation. The service was prompt, professional, friendly and effective. Feeling great!" Survey Participant

VISITATION PATTERNS AND RATIONALE


About 38% of participants are frequent library users, visiting the library 'every week', though the majority visit the library 'every month' or less.


Only 89 survey participants indicated that they didn't visit the library regularly. Respondents likely had different

perceptions of what 'regular' means however. The most common reasons stated for not visiting regularly include: buying books instead (26%), inconvenient hours (25%), and using the online library tools (23%). Additional reasons are included in the chart below.

Other reasons stated include:



Welcoming and Safe Atmosphere

A large majority (99%) of those with an opinion feel 'safe' using the library and a large majority (97%) also feel welcome at the library. Most of those 'strongly agree' with the statement.




Comments:

- Staff are welcoming, friendly and helpful x 48
- Agreement that it is welcoming x 45
- Space is designed to be bright and good for kids x 14
- No (too loud, too crowded, staff, etc) x 14
- Other: home away from home, homelessness there, hard to find things, good suggestions, place to relax, and unconventional

VISIT ACTIVITIES

The most common activity by survey participants during their visit to the library is still 'browsing for items to borrow' (81%), and this activity is followed by 'attending programs' (38%), 'reading for pleasure'(35%), 'studying or working' (31%) and 'using wifi on personal devices' (29%).


"The relaxed atmosphere is perfect for me but I appreciate that there may be a need to provide for those that prefer a 'quiet space' for studying and reading." Survey Participant

Desire for Quiet Areas

Most survey participants had a preference about quiet areas, with 32% preferring more quiet areas and 23% indicating a preference for 'no' more quiet areas. A total of 45% of respondents were indifferent to the idea.

Comments included:

- It's good as it is, quiet enough x 54
- Kids are loud, move study area away from kids areas x 18


Space Improvement Ranking


When asked about specific improvements to library space, participants most frequently ranked 'quiet study space' as the number one improvement (100), followed by 'more lounge space' (86), and more space to be creative (50).

Preferences for the top three rankings revealed a different pattern of preference with 'more lounge space' (220), 'quiet study space' (201), and 'more study stables'(163) being the most popular additions.



Computer Lab and Wifi Usage

Most survey participants indicated some use of the computer lab or wifi throughout the year, but those using it on a frequent basis ('every week' or 'every month') were the minority. In fact, 43% of participants indicated using the lab/wifi 'almost never or never'. That said, more than half the survey participants provided examples as to how wifi access, the computer lab and printing/scanning have helped them.




Comments on "How has access to wifi, computer lab, printing and ore scanning helped you?":

- Printer and scanner to help with job searches, home searches, residency, taxes and personal projects x 75
- Wifi for job search, home search, research, study, stay connected x 67
- Wifi is good saves me money, faster than at home x 57
- Work x 27

Of those who've used computers/wifi, 66% said they used it for checking or sending email, 59% used it for printing or scanning and 53% used it for researching something online. Other uses are described in the chart and list below.

"It is common to have wifi in public library. It has helped me when I first arrived in Whistler years ago to print resume and cover letter for employment opportunities." Survey Participant



TECHNOLOGY ADDITIONS

Respondents who indicated they had used the computer lab or wifi were also asked what type of technology they wish the library would provide. Of the 178 respondents, 50% indicated wireless printing, 30% indicated laptops and 28% indicated large format printing.



Feedback on the remaining technology addition suggestions is displayed in the chart and list below.

A total of 36 'other' suggestions included:

- None, n/a, (including 2 don't spend my tax \$\$) x 9
- Mac computers x 2
- Recording studio x 2
- Wireless printing x 2
- Other: exam room, DVDs, fax, ipads, Kindles, Adobe suite, photo printer, musical instruments, light table, sewing machine, free parking, seed library, video recorders, and exam rooms.


SERVICE QUALITY

A total of 410 survey participants providing input on service quality w 91% indicating 'excellent' services, 8% indicating 'fair' service and only 1% indicating 'not very good' service. In addition to the ratings, 87 participants provided feedback comments as listed below.

"The first time I came to the library, the staff were very helpful to get my card set up. And every time that I come to the library, they are always there to help with anything that I need." Survey Participant




NET PROMOTER SCORE

The 'net promoter score²' for the public library is quite high at 79%, with those very likely to promote the library representing 84% of respondents. There were very few 'detractors' (5%).

Many of those with an opinion on recommendations provided insight into their ratings, mostly positive.
