000 Introduction

The Whistler Public Library policies exist to ensure that the Board, Staff and Public are integrally connected with the library's purpose, vision, values and priorities. These policies provide guidance to ensure equitable service and a positive environment for those who interact with the library.

Under section 9 of the BC Library Act, the Board

- a. may make rules for managing its business and for regulating the use of its facilities and services by the public, [and]
- b. may appoint any committees of its members that it considers necessary to carry out its business.

The Board has developed and adopted a vision, purpose, and a strategic plan (Adopted: January 3, 2018 for the period 2018-2021). Library policies are developed, adopted, and revised in accordance with the current plan.
